We added an additional At Large Director to our board and sunset the Member At Large role to make our Board of Directors more effective. While meeting those needs, we were able to return in person to some of our long-standing and most loved events.

We celebrated A Shopping SPREE! together and in a new location. Shoppers and members were excited to be back. The consensus was that our new location at the Jim Graham Building at the NC State Fairgrounds was a success and the beginning of a great partnership.

In keeping with our financial commitment to the community, we once again awarded \$20,000 in Legacy Grants to 4 deserving local nonprofits.

Our Day of Giving continues to set new records. Contributions that totaled more than \$81,000 were collected during a 24-hour period and is a testament to the willingness of our members, their friends, and families to support the League not only with their time and talents but also financially.

Within our community, members of the Junior League of Raleigh continue to be known for their community impact by serving on community and advisory boards, being active members in their local schools and educational institutions and sitting on local councils shaping the future of our community.

This year has shown that we are still up to the challenge of serving our community, as we have for the past 92 years.


## JLR Trains & Engages


**Note in the Pocket** provides clothing to impoverished and homeless school-aged children in Wake County with dignity and love.



